

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION MATERIAL



Construction and Demolition (C&D) material is comprised of mixed heavy loads which usually contain a combination of timber, concrete, bricks, rubble, metal and plastics.

ResourceCo and Southern Waste ResourceCo accepts material in the Construction and Demolition, Commercial and Industrial and Mixed Construction and Demolition waste streams. This material is sorted and the ferrous and non-ferrous metals, inert fractions (bricks, concrete etc) and non-recyclables are removed.

All salvaged metals are then shipped to specialist external companies for sorting and recycling. The inert fractions are recycled by ResourceCo and resupplied to the civil construction market as an alternative to traditional quarried products.

Other waste streams accepted are asphalt, concrete and masonry, which are recycled into rubbles and road base materials, and Clean, Wet and Mixed Fill

This material stream is typically sourced from all stages of construction and demolition activities, final site clean-ups and domestic clean-ups using skip bins.



This material stream includes concrete, brick, rubble and small amounts of soil.
